#### Site Descriptives:

**Wadi Rum** – Known as the Valley of the Moon, Wadi Rum is a valley cut into the sandstone and granite rock in southern Jordan, to the east of the Gulf of Aqaba, with the largest wadi in Jordan. Experience Wadi Rum on a 2-hour jeep tour and see, touch, and feel the area's stunning desert landscape, spectacular sandstone mountains, desert valleys, canyons, dunes, arches.

**Petra** – The famous archaeological site in Jordan's southwestern desert, dating to around 300 BC, was the capital of the Nabatean Kingdom. Accessed via a narrow canyon called Al Siq, it contains tombs and temples carved into pink sandstone cliffs, earning its nickname as the "Rose City." Perhaps its most famous structure is the Al Khazneh temple with its ornate, Greek-style façade, also known as the Treasury, having been featured in the first Indiana Jones movie.

**Madaba** – Famous for the Madaba mosaic map, a floor mosaic located in the early-Byzantine church of Saint George in Madaba, it holds the world's oldest map of the Holy Land, with Jerusalem a central focus, appearing to be raised levels above all other sites on the map.

Mt. Nebo – In the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses ascended Mount Nebo to view the Land of Canaan which God had said he would not enter. Moses died in Moab, but had the opportunity for looking into the Promised Land from this site, where, if you stand at the cliff of the mountain, you can see many of the sites you will have experienced just a few days prior. It is a spiritually-awakening place in which to recite the Bible, expressing gratitude for the blessing of your having experienced the Holy Land.

"And Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, [to the] top of the summit facing Jericho.

And the Lord showed him all the Land: The Gilead until Dan, <sup>2</sup> and all [the Land of] Naftali, and the land of Ephraim and Manasseh, and all the land of Judah, until the western sea, <sup>3</sup> and the south, and the plain, the valley of Jericho, the city of palm trees, until Zoar.

<sup>4</sup> And the Lord said to him, "This is the Land I swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, saying,
'I will give it to your offspring.' I have let you see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there."

<sup>5</sup> And Moses, the servant of the Lord, died there, in the land of Moab, by the mouth of the Lord.

<sup>6</sup> And He buried him in the valley, in the land of Moab, opposite Beth Pe'or.

And no person knows the place of his burial, unto this day." (Deuteronomy 34:1-6, The Jewish Bible).
