The original Tel Aviv neighborhood

### **INDEPENDENCE HALL MUSEUM**

Historical and inspiring

### **PROMENADE**

Explore the Mediterranean beaches and shops

### **MASADA**

King Herod's magnificent fortress and place of the last heroic Jewish stand against the Romans

### **DEAD SEA**

Float in the salty waters of the Dead Sea – the lowest place on earth

### **EIN GEDI**

Nature reserve where David hid from the wrath of King Saul

### **QUMRAN**

Where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered

## **DAY 4**

### **MOUNT OF BEATITUDES**

Where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount

### **TABGHA**

Miracle of the loaves and fishes

### **MENSA CHRISTI**

Location of "feed my sheep" teaching



### **CAPERNAUM**

Center of Jesus' teachings and remains of 4<sup>th</sup> century synagogue

### **SEA OF GALILEE**

Boat ride on the Sea of Galilee

### **NOF GINOSAUR**

Galilee Boat

### **MOUNT ARBEL**

Overlooks Magdala (Migdal) – Panoramic view of the north of the Galilee where Jesus taught

## **DAY 5**

### **KORAZIM**

City cursed by Jesus

### **SAFED (ZVAT)**

Birthplace of Kaballah and highest city in Israel

### **HAZOR**

Biblical capital city

### **CAESAREA PHILLIPPI**

Where Jesus asked the question "Who do men say that I am?"

### **PEACE VISTA**

Golan Heights overview of the Galilee

### **YARDENIT**

Jordan baptismal site

## DAY 6

### **BEIT SHEAN**

Largest excavation in all of Israel

### **MEGIDDO**

26 ancient civilizations superimposed

### **NAZARETH**

City of Jesus' childhood

### **AKKO**

Ancient Crusader capital (Ptolemais on the Bible)

### **Overnight in Akko**

## DAY 7

### **ROSH HANIKRA**

White cliffs at the Lebanon border

### **HAIFA**

Israel's port city with Baha'i Gardens

### **MOUNT CARMEL AT MUKHRAKA**

Site where Elijah challenged the worshippers of Baal

### **CAESAREA MARITIMA**

Built by Herod the Great and seat of Roman rule

### **Overnight in Jerusalem**

## DAY 8

### **MOUNT SCOPUS**

Stop for a view of the Judean wilderness and Dead Sea area from Jerusalem

### **MOUNT OF OLIVES**

Enjoy your first view of the entire city of Jerusalem



### **HOSANNA ROAD**

Descend the mountain by foot on the same road that Jesus used on Palm Sunday

### **DOMINUS FLAVIT**

Visit the church that commemorates where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41)

### **GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE**

Visit the Church of All Nations and meet in the Garden where Jesus and the disciples would often come to pray and rest

### **SAINT PETER IN GALLICANTU**

The church commemorating Peter's denial of Jesus

### **BEN YEHUDA STREET**

Lunch and shopping

### **ISRAEL MUSEUM**

Shrine of the Book (where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept), Model of ancient Jerusalem

### **YAD VASHEM**

National Memorial and Museum of the Holocaust, Includes: Valley of the Communities, Hall of Names, Children's Memorial, and the new Museum complex

## **Overnight in Jerusalem**

## **DAY 9**

### **THE UPPER ROOM**

Where the disciples gathered after Jesus' ascension (Mark 14:12-26; Acts 1:13)

### **JEWISH QUARTER**

Rebuilt Jewish section of the city

### **CARDO**

Main street from the Roman-Byzantine times

### **WESTERN WALL (KOTEL)**

Judaism's most sacred site



## **SOUTHERN WALL EXCAVATION – DAVIDSON CENTER**

Computerized virtual model of the Second Temple

### **TEMPLE STEPS**

The actual steps used by Jesus and the people of His time to enter the Temple (Psalms of Ascent)

### **CITY OF DAVID**

Ongoing excavation in the ancient core of Jerusalem built by King David, including sophisticated underground water system

### **POOL OF SILOAM**

Where Jesus cured a blind man with a mud mixture and told him to go wash it from his eyes (John 9)

## **Overnight in Jerusalem**

## **DAY 10**

### **MEA SHE'ARIM**

Drive through this Ultra-Orthodox Jewish Neighborhood

### **WESTERN WALL TUNNELS**

Rabbinic Tunnels revealing the base of the Temple Mount and the street level during the time of Jesus

### **POOLS OF BETHESDA**

Where Jesus healed the lame man (John 5:1-24)

### **ST. ANNE'S CHURCH**

### **VIA DOLOROSA**

Stations of the Cross leading to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher

### **CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHER**

Considered by Catholics to be the location of the death, burial and resurrections of Jesus

### **ARAB MARKET (SHUK)**



### **DAVID'S CITADEAL MUSEUM**

The exhibits depict 4,000 years of Jerusalem's history

### **GARDEN TOMB AND GORDON'S CALVARY**

Considered by Evangelicals to be the site of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus

## **Overnight in Jerusalem**

## **DAY 11**

### **EIN KAREM**

The traditional hometown of Zechariah and Elizabeth, and the birthplace of John the Baptist (Luke 1)

### **VALLEY OF AYALON**

Where Joshua called on the Lord to make the moon stand still (Joshua 10:12-13)

### **EMMAUS**

The road to which Jesus appeared to two of his disciples when they left Jerusalem after his crucifixion (Luke 24:13-35)

### **VALLEY OF ELAH**

Where David fought Goliath (1 Samuel 17)

### **TEL AZEKAH**

Enjoy the fine overview of the famous battleground

### **BEIT GUYRIN NATIONAL PARK AND TEL MARESHA**

The Israelite/Idumean town of Maresha – believed to be the birthplace of King Herod. Visit the underground network of man-made caves and see the Roman amphitheater

### **NEOT KEDUMIM BIBLICAL LANDSCAPE RESERVE**

Where the flora of the Scripture comes alive, along with biblical tools and industrial implements: oil presses, wine presses, cisterns and more

### **MINI ISRAEL**

Theme park, with over 400 precise scale models of sites and monuments throughout the country, is a fun and interesting way to end your day and your Israel experience
